LOCATION

The Manzanar Airstrip: Located 10 miles north of the city of Lone Pine at the Manzanar Reward Road sign (on the right, may be hard to see at night), go 1/4 mile east of US 395 and you're there.

ELIGIBILITY

MUST BE 18 years of age (16 to 17 years of age with a minor release form signed by legal guardian) and hold a valid driver's license. No memberships required. Due to the high speed nature of this event, it is recommended for experienced competitors.

SAFETY

COMMON SENSE! - MUST WEAR SEAT BELTS AND HELMET (some loaners available). **Helmets must be SNELL/SA 2000 or newer.** No DOT helmets. Open vehicles must have a roll bar OR factory option hardtop, or equivalent. NO alcoholic beverages or other intoxicants may be used by drivers, crew or spectators during each day's event; after the course is closed - have a BLAST! Please observe a 5 mph speed limit in pits.

CAR PREPARATION / CLASSIFICATION

SOLO, Club Racing, SCCA, IMSA, VINTAGE, NASA, the family sled, or whatever. We will find a class for you. 5 or more pre-registered drivers who want to run their own class may do so (commonly known as rent-a-racer). OPEN EXHAUST if your class allows it. Basic car classification will be per the 2017 SCCA National Solo rule book. Still not sure what class? - provide details on how your car is prepared on the entry form (engine, suspension, tires & wheels, etc.) and we'll find a place for you. Unsafe vehicles will be turned away. **This is not an autocross event. It is a high speed time trial.**
